

Chicago CDs with Maynard Ferguson

CHICAGO, CHICAGO 13 -- Rhino R2 76182

By now, you've all heard the story, right? Back in 1979, Maynard and Chicago were across the hall from each other in the recording studio. He was recording the "Hot" album, and Chicago was recording "13." They invited Maynard over to jam with them on the track "Street Player," and here it is! Wow! Sort of jazz meets rock meets disco. You've GOT to have this one! BONUS: This is the 2003 re-issue CD, and it has an ALTERNATE MIX of Street Player along with the original mix. Very cool!

COPY #1. This one is MINT, FACTORY SEALED. \$10.00.

COPY #2. This copy is in almost new condition -- NMINT+. \$8.00.

Chicago 45s with Maynard Ferguson

CHICAGO, STREET PLAYER (BOTH SIDES) -- Columbia 1-11124

This is a white label DJ copy. Street Player is on both sides of the 45. Maynard, of course, sat in with Chicago on this session.

CHICAGO, STREET PLAYER/WINDOW DREAMIN' (DUTCH RELEASE) -- CBS 8040

This is a rare Dutch paper picture cover 45 with MF playing on Street Player. Exceptionally hard to find, especially in the U.S.

COPY #1. This is the first copy of this rare 45 I've ever had for sale on the website. The picture cover on this one has a couple of light creases at upper left, and there's a little surface wear visible, front and back. Still, it's an EX+ cover. The disc has clean and nice labels, and the vinyl itself has one scuff and a number of light surface scratches. It plays with some surface noise audible on playback. I'd rate the disc as EX-. Overall, this copy is in the EX range. Due to its rarity, it's \$15.00. NO COPIES AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME.

Chicago 12-Inch Singles

CHICAGO, STREET PLAYER / BOZ SCAGGS, LOWDOWN -- Columbia 43-11138

This is a very rare 12" single with Chicago's Street Player on one side, and Boz Scaggs' Lowdown on the other. It has plum colored vinyl, and white promo labels Street Player tracks at 8:11, Lowdown at 5:15. Truly a rare and desirable 12" single!

COPY #1. This copy comes in a plain, black, generic 12" single cover. That's typical, as the other two copies I've seen were identically packaged. The cover is NMINT-. The labels on the disc are clean

and nice, and the disc itself is almost certainly MINT, never played. A super nice copy of this rare and desirable 12" single. This LP is very popular with DJs so commands a higher price. \$35.00.

CHICAGO, STREET PLAYER / WINDOW DREAMIN' (U.K. RELEASE) -- S CBS 12 8040

The Chicago Street Player 12" 45 RPM single is an ULTRA HOT item with the disco DJs. These sell in internet auctions here in the U.S. for anywhere from \$75.00 to \$200.00!!! I've seen more than a dozen of them sell for in excess of \$100.00! And this is a much rarer U.K. CBS version of this hot disc. Street Player tracks at 8:40, Window Dreamin' at 4:07. Truly a rare and desirable 12" single! COPY #1. Just in, this one is in a CBS UK disco sleeve with the original Street Player label at upper right. The cover is pretty nice with just a little ring wear being the only detracting factor. It's NMINT-. The labels are clean and nice, and the vinyl has one visible scuff and several ultra-light surface scratches that don't significantly affect play. To be sure, I spun it up, and it plays beautifully! I'd rate it as EX+ based on appearance, but it plays even better. Overall, this copy is EX++. A nice, solid copy of a rare and desirable disco single. Because I got a decent deal on it, it's yours for just \$45.00.

Chicago LPs with Maynard Ferguson

CHICAGO, CHICAGO 13 -- Columbia FC 36105

By now, you've all heard the story, right? Back in 1979, Maynard and Chicago were across the hall from each other in the recording studio. He was recording the "Hot" album, and Chicago was recording "13." They invited Maynard over to jam with them on the track "Street Player," and here it is! Wow! Sort of jazz meets rock meets disco. You've GOT to have this one!

COPY #1. The cover on this copy has four visible nicks along the top seam, and a very, very slight amount of ring wear, visible only on the back at the top. Someone wrote their name in small letters inside the cover, which means you can only see it if you open the cover and look inside. I'd rate this cover as EX+. The vinyl has a few light surface scratches which don't affect play significantly. It's easily EX. Overall, this copy is EX to EX+. \$5.00.

COPY #2. The cover on this one is very nice, with just the faintest hint of record ring wear on the back. It's still NMINT. The vinyl is super, also NMINT. Overall, this copy is NMINT. \$8.00.

COPY #3. The cover on this one has just the slightest record ring wear front and back. But there are zero other problems, so it's still NMINT. The vinyl has one long surface scuff, which reduces it from NMINT to just NMINT-. Overall, this copy is NMINT- to NMINT. \$7.00.

COPY #4. The cover on this one has a corner bend at bottom left, and a couple of nicks on the corners, as well as slight record ring wear. It's EX-. The vinyl is very nice -- NMINT-. Overall, this copy is EX to EX+. \$5.00.

COPY #5. The cover on this one has just the slightest corner bend at bottom left, but otherwise it looks like it's brand new. It's NMINT to NMINT+. The vinyl is SUPER!!! It looks never-played, NMINT+++!!! Overall, this copy is NMINT+ -- one of the nicest you're going to find. \$9.00.

COPY #6. This copy is MINT, FACTORY SEALED. Essentially, it's brand new. \$11.00.

COPY #7. This copy is MINT, FACTORY SEALED. Essentially, it's brand new. \$11.00.

COPY #8. The cover on this one is a clean and nice NMINT. The vinyl is likewise NMINT. Overall, a super, NMINT copy. \$8.00.

COPY #9. The cover on this one is NMINT+. The vinyl is NMINT+, and may be never played.

Overall, NMINT+. \$9.00

CHICAGO, CHICAGO 13 (JAPANESE PRESSING) -- CBS/Sony 25AP 1602

Here's the Japanese version of the Chicago 13 LP. Much rarer than the U.S. version, it's also pressed on much nicer vinyl!

COPY #1. The cover on this copy is a clean and nice NMINT. The vinyl is likewise NMINT, and this LP retains its original custom inner sleeve and liner notes. A beautiful copy, it's \$15.00.
